The Board of Directors wish to announce that Vermont House, the residential home for retired Christian Scientists in Sutton Coldfield, West Midlands, has now closed. In making this announcement, we would like to record some of the achievements of Vermont House -

- Vermont House has been meeting the needs of retired Christian Scientists for over 60 years. During that time it has seen many healings take place among the residents and also the staff. It has been run by a series of able and enthusiastic managers, some of whom were not Christian Scientists, but all of whom who were very supportive of the healing work of Christian Science. The carers have been drawn from a wide range of nationalities in the local community. They have also been supportive of Christian Science as a way of life for the residents; some have even gone on to become Christian Science nurses.
- Vermont has over the years been a focus of Christian Science activity in the Midlands area. Members and young people from First Church of Christ, Scientist, Sutton Coldfield have regularly come to share music there. Other Christian Science churches in Birmingham and the Midlands have shown their support in practical ways. Church members from further afield have regularly come to our garden parties and other events, and we have always had a loyal group of Associates.
- Vermont has also made an impact on the local community and has received assistance from local charities from time to time. It has always had good relations with the local authority social services and has consistently obtained an 'excellent' rating as a care home. As occasion required, the house has welcomed district nurses and GPs, many of whom have expressed appreciation for the healing atmosphere.
- Over the years, a number of Christian Science charities in the British Field have generously supported the work of Vermont House. The successive Boards of Vermont Trust have been ably assisted by a series of dedicated secretary/treasurers. Board members have freely given their time and expertise on a wide range of issues relating to the house.

We wish to express our gratitude for all the good that has flowed through Vermont House.


